Type of School/Institution(refer to item No.10)

GOVERNMENT- A Government school is that which is run by the State Government or Public sector Undertaking or an Autonomous organization completely financed by the Government.

LOCAL BODY- A Local Body school is that which is run by Panchayti raj and local body institutions such as Zila parishad, Municipal Corporation, Municipal Committee and Cantonment Board.

PRIVATE AIDED- A private aided school is that which is run by an individual or a private organization and receives grant from government or local body.

PRIVATE UNAIDED- Private Unaided School is that which is managed by an individual or a private organization and does not receive any grant from government or local body.
