(ii) Multiple Assessment

Multiple Assessment is alternate mode of assessment as per the demand of the subject as a part of Internal Assessment, it gives flexibility to use multiple and diverse techniques to assess learners viz. observation,

oral tests, individual or group work, class discussion, field work, concept maps, graphic organizers, visual representations, submission of assignments/home work/holidays homework etc.

(iii) Portfolio

It is a collection of intentionally chosen student's work representing a selection of performances that assembled (in a single file with separator/folder for all subjects) over time and describes the student's efforts, progress, growth & achievement. Integrated activities can also be undertaken or it can be CBSE prescribed work.

(iv) Subject Enrichment Activities

Subject Enrichment Activities comprising various techniques like ASL/Reading/ Dictation/ Debate/Public Speaking/creating prose/ poetry/ blogs/ audios/videos etc. for languages and home based experiments & Activities/Projects/ Map Work /audios/videos etc. in rest of the subjects.

Co-Scholastic Assessment

Work Education, Art Education and Health and Physical Education will be judged under Co- Scholastic areas. These assessments will be carried out during online classes through observation.

Discipline

Discipline will be another Co Scholastic field which will be judged under **Attendance**, **Regularity and Punctuality**, **Sincerity**, **Behaviour and Values**. These assessments will be carried out during online classes through observations.
